

Is the Home Scoutmaster Involved? The conference is designed to strengthen the relationship between the youth leader and his Scoutmaster. The Scoutmaster or another Troop adult leader is strongly encouraged to attend an after-conference session with the youth leader on how to best use the newly trained youth leader in the Troop. At this session on July 17 the Scout and the adult leader will agree on the application of leadership skills learned at the conference that will benefit the Troop's program and help to develop the Scout's leadership skills.

Is any Special Equipment Needed? An equipment list will be sent to each participant after the reservation is received. Scouts who participate in an active Troop outdoor program probably already have the necessary personal equipment. An *official Boy Scout uniform* is required. (The new uniform released in the summer of 2008 or any previous official B.S.A. uniform is acceptable.) Each participant should make sure that badges and insignia are properly placed and that the uniform is worn correctly.

What About Medical Forms? Scouts must use the medical form found at www.tenmileriver.org or available from GNYC Camping Services. All medical forms must have been completed after July 17, 2009.

What Does NYLT Cost? The conference fee is \$360.00, which includes all food and training materials. **For reservations fully paid by May 31, there is a \$30.00 discount, or a total fee of \$330.00.** A deposit of \$50.00 per Scout should accompany each reservation. The balance must be paid by May 31. Some camperships may be available for Scouts from Greater New York Councils – apply early. The fee does not cover personal uniform and equipment nor transportation to and from camp.

One T-shirt is included with the course fee. Additional T-shirts and course photographs will be available for sale. Please pre-order them by June 30 through the web at www.bsa-gnyc.org/NYLT-stuff.

If you are thinking of sending Scouts to NYLT, please sign them up early as there is room for only a limited number of participants.

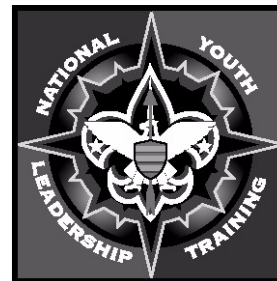

NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING CONFERENCE

Purpose: The training of youth leaders is a vital ingredient needed to develop a high-performing Boy Scout Troop and foster the personal growth of its Scouts. The Boy Scouts of America has developed a week-long training experience, the **National Youth Leadership Training Conference** (NYLT), that has proven valuable in the training of youth leaders. The conference will stress the skills of leadership that will make youth leaders more effective in their Troop leadership positions.

Perhaps more importantly, the Scout will acquire life skills that will enable him to become a successful leader in any organization. This course will provide the Scout with the tools that he needs to develop his leadership potential. The skills he will learn will facilitate immensely the Scoutmaster's leadership development of the Scout and directly benefit the Troop's program.

Qualifications: Any Scout who participates in the conference must be at least a First Class Scout and 13 years old (but not yet 18), and a Scout that **the Scoutmaster** feels is mature and currently filling a Troop leadership position or likely to assume a leadership position in the near future. The Scout may **only** attend on the Scoutmaster's recommendation. As the conference will be conducted at camp, it is important that the Scout have camping, cooking and hiking skills.

Location and Time: The conference will be held from July 11 to July 17, 2010 at Camp Keowa, Ten Mile River Scout Camps. The conference will be led by Course Director Bosco Chao and conducted by an excellent group of experienced youth and adult trainers.

Sabbath Observance: The conference will be held at Camp Keowa. Kosher food will be available to all staff and participants who request it. Sabbath Observant Scouts can make arrangements to stay over

after the conference and leave camp on Sunday for a nominal fee. Sabbath observant leadership will be on-site at Keowa during the conference. For more information on these arrangements, please contact one of the people listed under "For More Information" on the other side of this page.

NYLT FACTS

What is the Conference? The National Youth Leadership Training Conference is a one week outdoor experience for youth leaders in support of the Scoutmaster's responsibility for training the Troop's youth leaders. It is conducted by the Greater New York Council's Leadership Training Committee using a syllabus published by the Boy Scouts of America.

What is its Purpose? Scouting recognizes that Scoutmasters have the responsibility of training their own youth leaders. The purpose of the National Youth Leadership Training Conference is not to assume the Scoutmaster's role, but to support it. The conference's objectives are:

1. To enhance the relationship between the participant and his Scoutmaster.
2. To have fun.
3. To give participants a basic knowledge of the skills of leadership and help them relate these skills to their Troop responsibilities.
4. To give participants the opportunity to share ideas and experiences with Scouts from other Troops.
5. To give participants the confidence and knowledge to run the Troop program.
6. To create an atmosphere where Scouts will experience Scouting at its best.
